1. Package Contents

2. Installing The Modem

- 1. Turn off your computer.
- 2. Open the case of your PC and plug the Internal PCI Modem card into a free PCI slot on your motherboard.
- 3. Fix the Internal PCI Modem card onto your case and then close your computer case.
- 4. Unplug the telephone line from the wall socket, then plug the telephone line into the socket on the back of the modem marked **PHONE**.
- 5. Plug the phone cord supplied into the socket on the back of the modem marked **LINE** then Plug the other end of the cord into the wall socket.
- 6. Power on your computer.
- 7. This completes the setting up of your modem hardware. Please proceed to the next section for information on **installing the modem drivers** in Windows 98SE/ME/XP/2000.

- 2. A "Location Information" wizard will pop-up. Fill in your location information then click "Close" to continue.
- A "Make New Connection" wizard will pop-up during the driver installation process. Follow the windows instruction step by step, the windows wizard will guards you to complete the setting.
